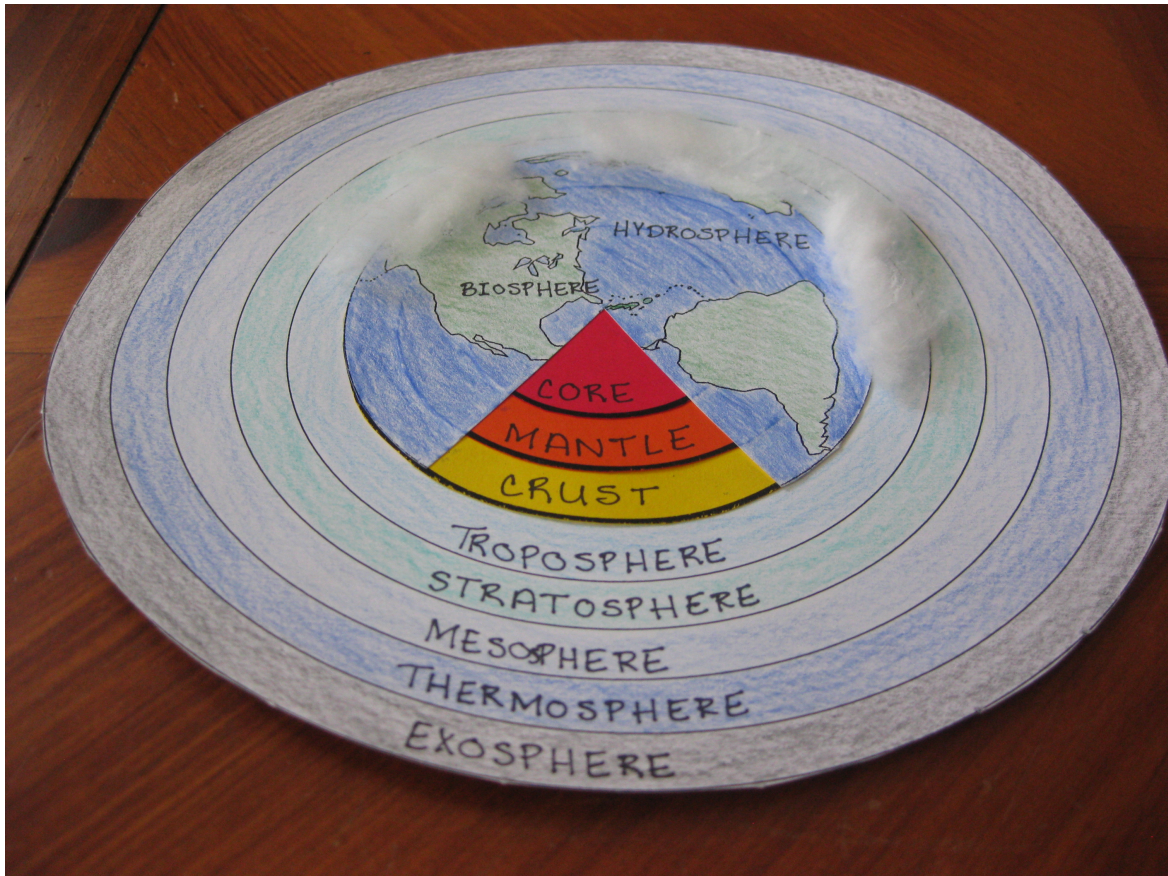


Layers of the Earth & Atmosphere Project

Print "Mantle" on orange cardstock paper,

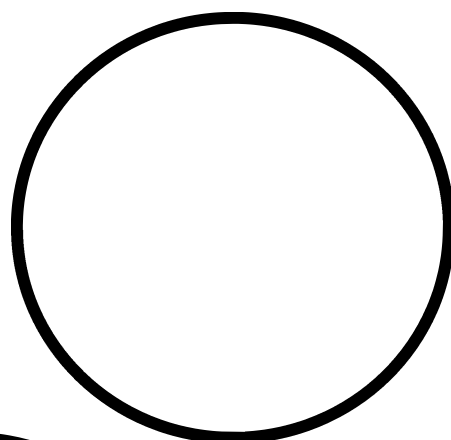
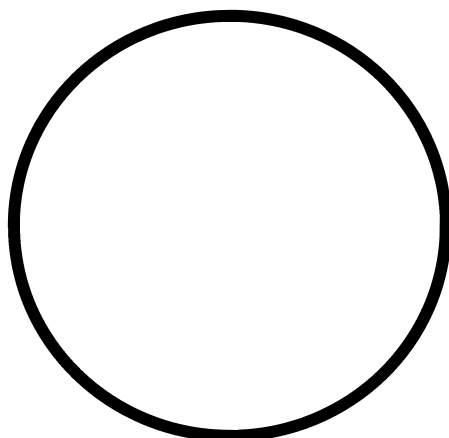
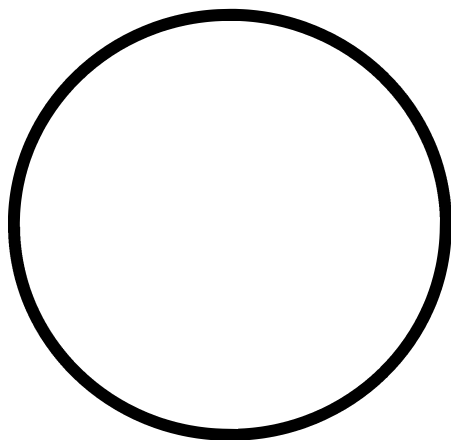
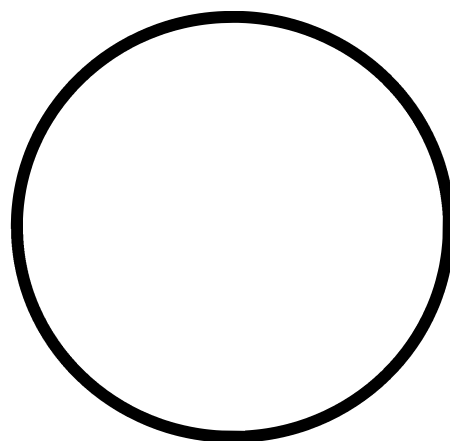
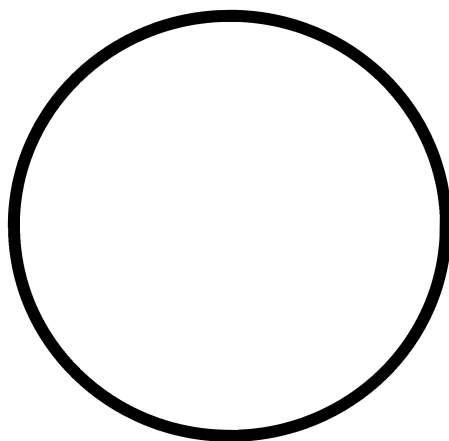
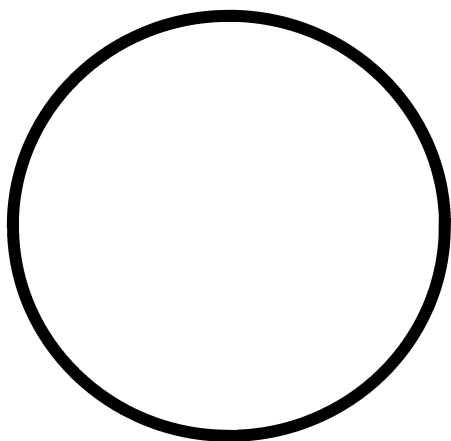
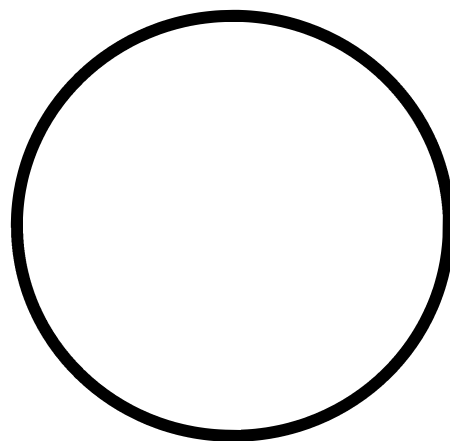
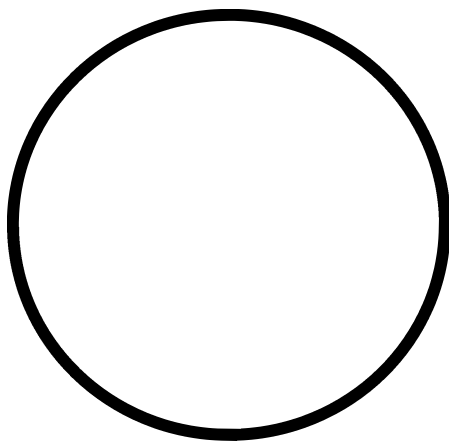
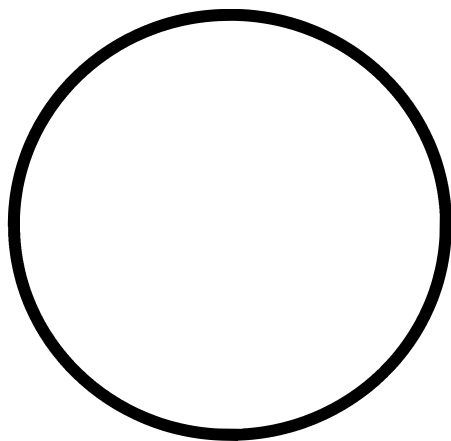
Print "Crust" on yellow cardstock paper.

Glue layers on top of each other.

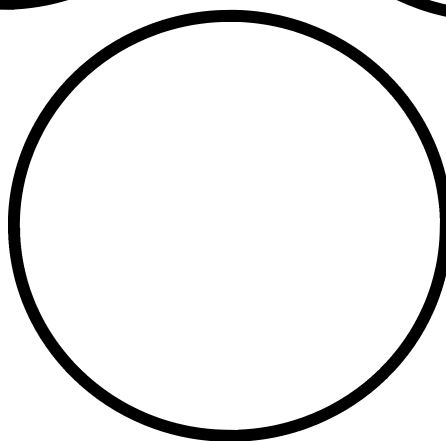

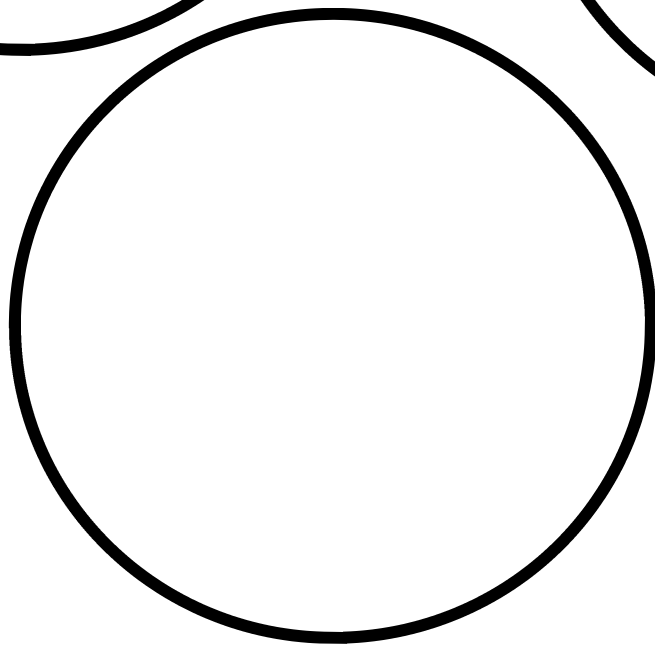
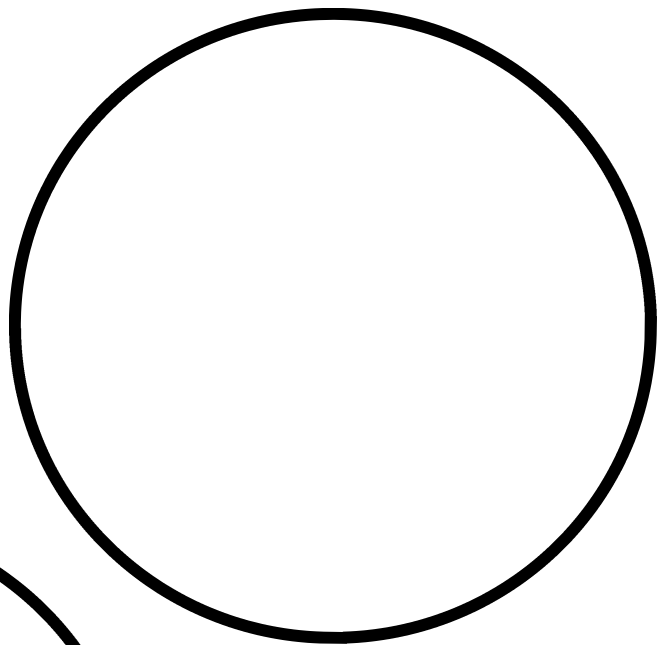
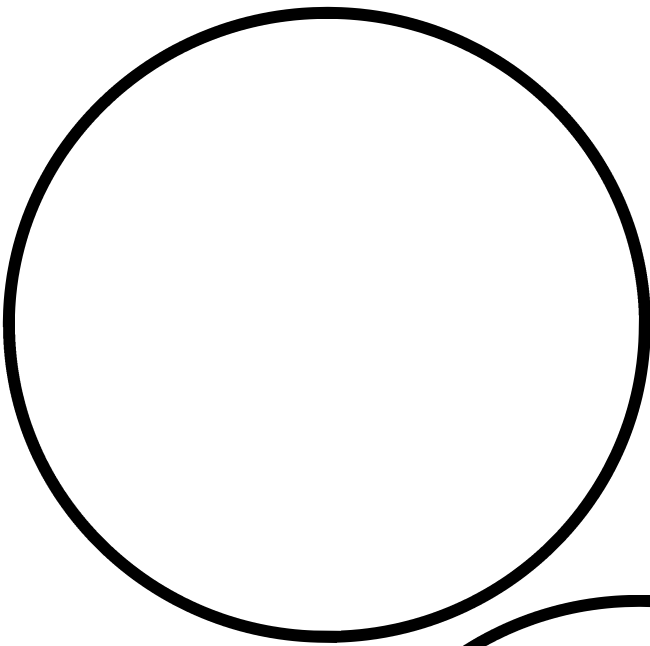
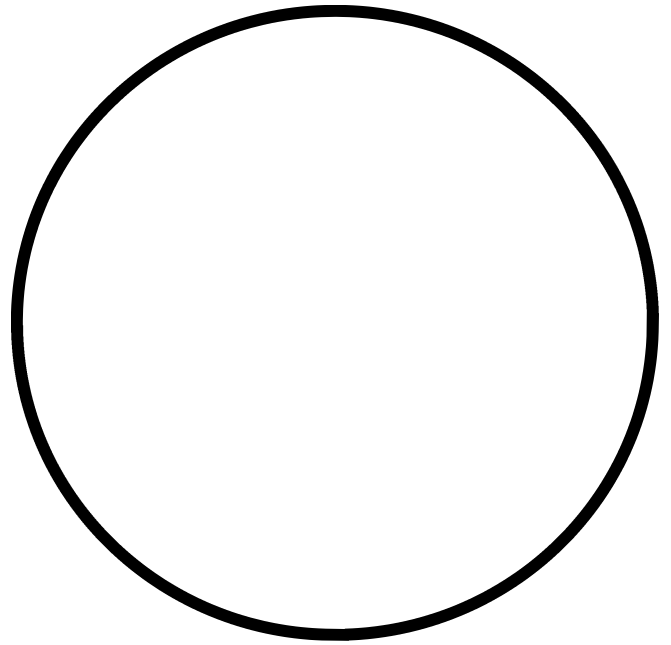
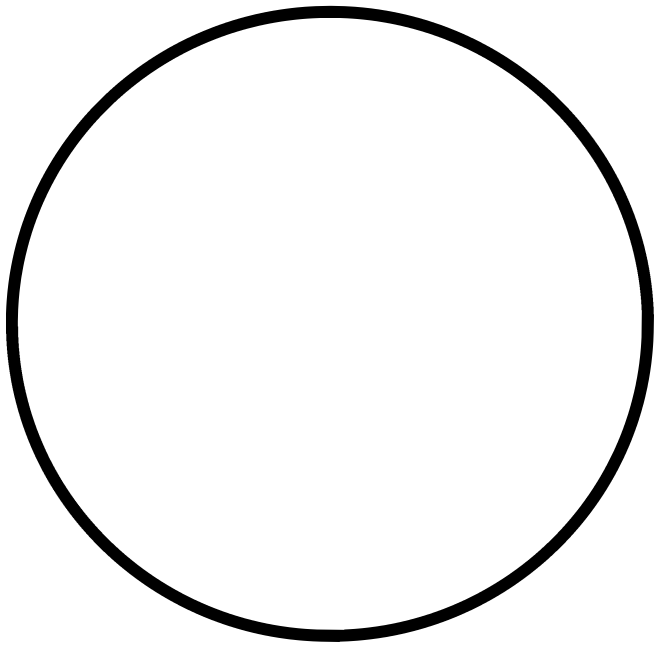
Print layers of the atmosphere (pg 6) on white cardstock paper, label each layer, and color each layer a different color.

Glue "earth" in the middle and glue on "clouds" made from cotton balls.

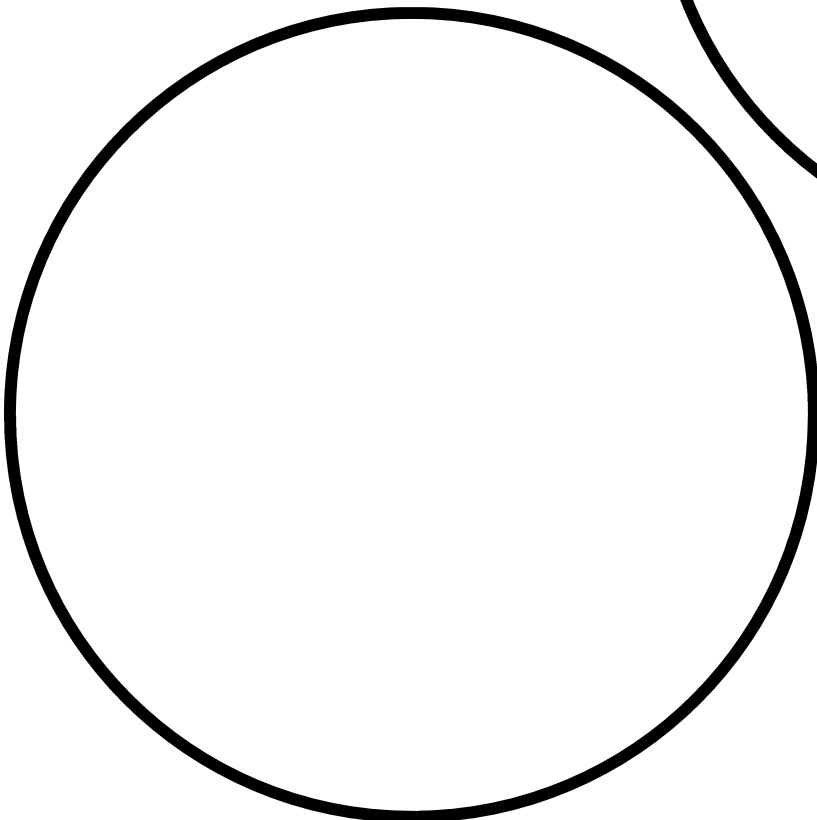
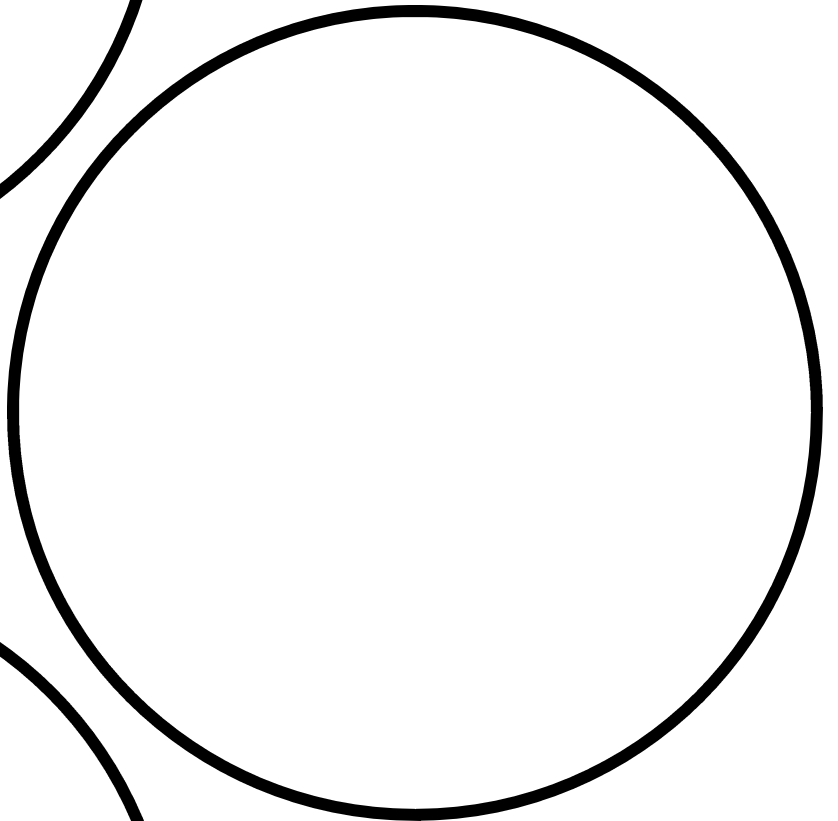
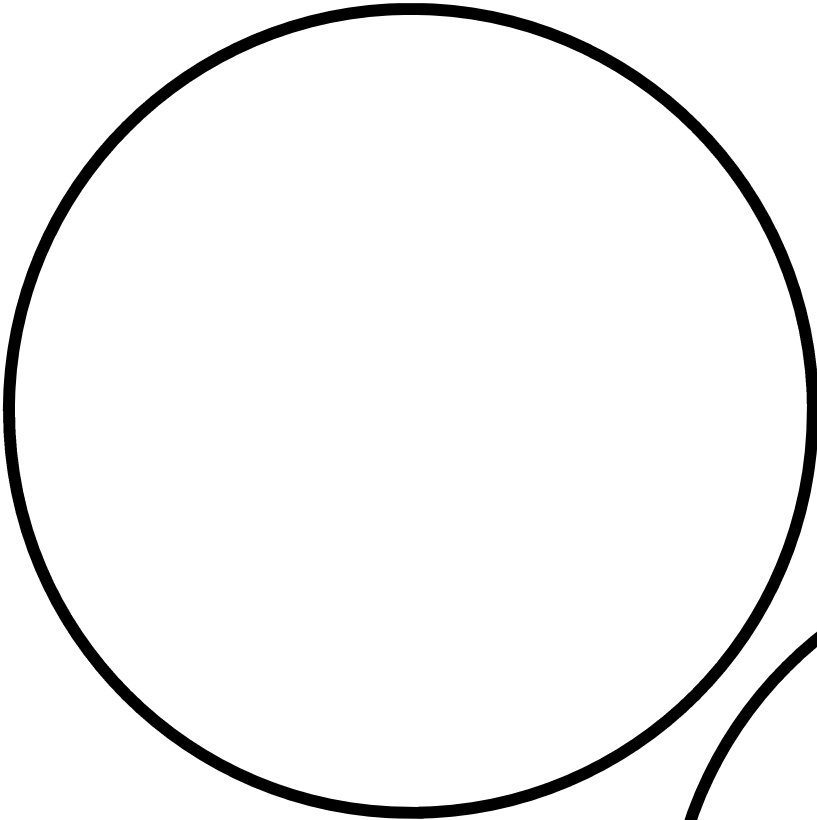


CORE -

cardstock paper




CRUST -
