



Portrait on Landscape

Goal: To guide students to reproduce recognizable sample of work in short time and to ignite students' interest in exploring further at home.

- 1. Use big brush and lots of water. Wash light blue on top and green on bottom and upper tree area.
- 2. Use flat or round medium brush. Dab yellow green and green per painting.
- 3. Use flat or round medium brush. Make dryer vertical strokes with brown for tree, er painting. Use tiny brush for left tree trunk.
- 4. Use round medium brush. Use lots of water for blue sky per painting. Can mix grey in it.
- Use flat or round medium brush. Dab brown and dark green per painting.
- 6. Use tiny flat or round brush. DAB blue/grey in water. DAB green in trees. DAB yellow in trees. DAB yellow, white/cream, grey etc.
