Texture Paints

Goal: To guide students to reproduce recognizable sample of work in short time and to ignite students' interest in exploring further at home.

I suggest painting like the Gainsborough with texture used for accents (last ten mins). Do a wash for sky, water, field and foreground. I will texture the white paint for clouds and waves. I will texture gold for the fields and green for trees. I will texture light brown for foreground with sand and black for the dress.

Wheatfields

- 1. Do wash for sky, wheat fields, and foreground.
- 2. Blot area for man and trees with paper towel if surface is very wet. Paint farmer and trees using Monet's dabbing technique and a tiny brush. Barns optional.
- 3. Use (textured) green and tiny brush for strip of grass. This provides contrast for tops of wheat.
- 4. Use textured white for fluffy clouds, and barns.
- 5. Use textured light gold for wheat dabbing for tops and scratching with toothpicks for stalks.
- 6. Use textured green for trees.
- 7. Use textured brown for dirt in foreground.
