

Mirror Image Activity for Non-Writing Abecedarians

Purpose: I have a few Abecedarians (~4yo range) who are non-writers – as in, not even used to holding a pencil. While we still intend to practice *drawing* mirror images, this activity afterwards is great for helping non-writers feel like they can make mirror images successfully. Hopefully without tears. 😊

Prep Work: Print both pages for every student in class. Use one page as a base map. Cut out the shapes from the second page (I recommend printing second page on colored paper for contrast). Put the shapes in a baggie for each student.

Instructions: Have students match the cut-out shapes (from their bag) to the base map. Glue or tape if desired.
