

# Cycle 2 Week 5 Art Project: Perspective Drawing Abecedarians

Materials: Printed pages, scissors, blue markers, glue sticks

#### Instructions

- Print the background page and cut-out page for each child.
- 2.) Cut out the trees, duck, and clouds.
- 3.) In class, explain that perspective drawing has two elements: a horizon line and a vanishing point. The horizon line is a horizontal line across a picture that separates the ground or earth from the sky. It is always at eyellevel

The **vanishing point** in perspective drawing is a point on the horizon line to which receeding parallel lines appear to meet.

#### Io nelp

If you lined up the children shoulder to shoulder in front of you, you would have two imaginary lines that are parallel: connecting all the heads together would create an imaginary line. same with the feet...parallel lines. Now turn 90 degrees and imagine children lining up till you couldn't see them anymore. Those parallel lines receed to a point on the horizon: the vanishing point.

## 4.) Introduce the project...

Background page: The picture of the background has a **horizon line** (the green hills) and a **vanishing point** (where the horizon line and the dotted "x" meet). The "x" is the parallel lines that receed into the horizon.

### Draw a river...

Take a blue marker and draw a line from the vanishing point to the bottom corners of the background. Stay close to the two dotted lines on the bottom.

Color in the river.

6.) Place and paste...

Trees: Explain that the trees are actually the same size in real life but when we place them on the picture, we are creating an illusion of depth. They are to go on the right and left of the picture. The top of the "x" is where the top of the tree goes. The bottom line of the "x" is where the roots go. Clouds: Again, the clouds are the same size in real life but when we place them on the picture, we stay within the dotted lines.


Duck: Just for fun....!
